Wildcats Win Holiday Tournament

During Winter break the boys' basketball team went to work. The boys competed in the New Egypt Holiday Tournament and captured the crown. In the first game, on Friday, Dec. 27, the Wildcats beat New Egypt by a score 32-22. Pinelands took complete control of the game and outlasted New Egypt in every quarter. Josh Kline had 7 points and 5 rebounds; Ryan Skeie tallied 7 points and 7 rebounds; Anthony Falduto chipped in 7 points, and Andrew Bartlett scored 2 points and grabbed 10 rebounds. The Cats then advanced to the championship game on Saturday, Dec. 28, against Steinert H.S. After trailing 27-20 at halftime, Pinelands outscored their opponent 26-13 in the second half. The game was forced into overtime as Steinert hit a desperation three at the buzzer. The Wildcats played hard and stayed solid as they outlasted Steinert 7-3 in the overtime period, grabbing the win by a final score of 53-49. Skeie led all scorers with 22 points and 10 rebounds; Kline chipped in 13 points; O'Rourke added 10 points; and Ed Wilkinson scored 4 points & grabbed 4 rebounds. Skeie was awarded tournament MVP and Kline was selected to the All-Tournament Team. To start the New Year, the Wildcats traveled to Manchester on Friday, Jan. 3, and fell short by a final score of 46-37. Kline and Skeie led the team with 12 points each and Bartlett added 6 points 5 rebounds. The Wildcats next hosted Lakewood on Monday, Jan. 6, in their first home game, but it was not meant to be. The Wildcats came out flat and were outscored 13-4 in the first quarter and then were held scoreless in the second quarter. Pinelands picked it up in the second half, playing the Piners even, but they were too far behind to get back in the game. The Cats fell by a final score of 44-24. Kline led the team with 7 points, while Skeie and Wilkinson added 5 points a piece. Pinelands then hosted Jackson Liberty H.S. on Thursday, Jan. 9. After suffering a devastating loss of their starting forward, Bartlett, to a season ending injury in the Lakewood game, the Cats held strong and defeated the Lions by a final score of 51-40. Skeie recorded a double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds; Kline tallied 9 points and 10 assists; Anthony Falduto added 9 points and 5 assists; and R. O'Rourke chipped in 8 points for the Wildcats. Pinelands is now 3-3 on the season and will travel to ACIT tonight in hopes of picking up another win on the road.
