On behalf of the Pinelands Administrative Team, we would like to sincerely <u>thank you</u> for your continued patience while we implement Remote Learning for our students. Please review the following guidelines to further support your children at home.

Student Attendance: If a student is sick and unable to work online, students are to email attendance@prsdnj.org

Student Daily/ Weekly Requirements:

- Students are required to engage in Remote Learning for a minimum of 2 hours per day (a minimum of 10 hours per week). This is not an exact science. Some students will need to work longer than others, and the intensity of the learning may differ in a higher-level course, such as Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment.
- Teachers will meet student needs related to established additional school supports (ELL, 504, IEP, I&RS) will have their work modified based upon their needs. This may include additional time and resources for these students during these remote learning days as well as upon their return to school. It is up to the individual teacher to determine the needs of each student in their classes in order to meet the NJ Learning Standards for their courses.
- Again, the classroom teacher will give individual guidance on the expectations for students in their classes.
